



Florida A&M University Birmingham Metro Chapter Alumni Scholarship 2010

This is a general scholarship awarded by the Birmingham Metro Chapter of the FAMU National Alumni Association. This scholarship is awarded to the Greater Birmingham area students that will attend FAMU in the fall or students that are currently matriculating at FAMU full-time.

Eligibility (Incoming Freshman)

Candidates for scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Student must be a U. S. Citizen and a resident of the Greater Birmingham area (Jefferson and Shelby counties)
- Student must attend a Jefferson or Shelby county area high school.
- Student must graduate high school by June of 2010.
- Student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Student must have two recommendations (one from a teacher or counselor and the other non-academic).
- Student must type a 150 word (minimum) essay expressing why you chose to attend Florida A&M University.
- Student will attend Florida A&M University in the fall.
- **Upon notification as an award recipient, student must produce an acceptance letter from Florida A&M University.**

Eligibility (Current FAMU Student)

Candidates for scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Student must be a U. S. Citizen and a resident of the Greater Birmingham area (Jefferson and Shelby counties)
- Student must be enrolled as a full-time student.
- Student must have graduated from Jefferson or Shelby county area high school.
- Student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Student must have two recommendations (one from a teacher or counselor and the other non-academic).
- Student must type a 150 word (minimum) essay expressing why you chose to attend Florida A&M University.

Selection

Scholarship recipients are determined by the FAMU-BMC Chapter Scholarship/Education Committee.

Awards

Award amount varies.

NOTE: Awards are paid to the university for incoming freshman.

The Application Package

Consideration will be given **ONLY** to candidates submitting complete application packages

- (1) A completed scholarship application form (copies are acceptable)
- (2) An official high school transcript (incoming freshman)
- (3) An official FAMU transcript (current FAMU Student)
- (3) A well written essay (minimum of 150 words)
- (4) Two letters of recommendation (one academic and one non-academic)

Complete application packages **MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN May 1, 2010 to be considered the FAMU NAA BMC General Scholarship.**
